Budgeting and Saving for School

Don't get caught off guard: Set up a budget and spending plan before you start school.

Budgeting for post-secondary education or training can be challenging. Many expenses such as rent or books can be difficult to predict. Setting up a budget and spending plan before you start your studies can help you manage your money better and save you a lot of stress. **Revise your budget and spending plan throughout the year** to help keep you on track.

The five-step money management system

Managing your money is easy! All it takes is a little organization. Here's how it works:

- 1. Identify every source of income: savings, employment income, grants, bursaries, student loans and scholarships.
- 2. Determine your up-front, one-time expenses such as tuition, books and damage deposit for rent. Watch for unexpected administration fees.
- 3. Determine your monthly income. TIP: student loan funds are usually given in one or two payments. Divide your loan by the number of months you're in school.
- 4. Determine your monthly expenses such as food, rent, utilities and transportation.
- 5. Record your expenses. Keep all your receipts and review and revise your spending plan on a monthly basis

- provides customer service relating to your student financial assistance through interactive online services, email and telephone.
